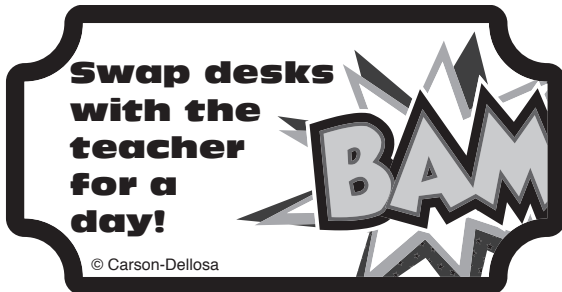

### Putting It Together

- Use pieces of the Super Power Heroic Students Mini Bulletin Board to create fun curriculum games and activities.

## Using the Super Power Heroic Students Mini Bulletin Board

Place the Super Power Heroic Students Mini Bulletin Board posters around the room or on a bulletin board to remind and encourage students to display heroic character traits throughout the day.

### Classroom Management

**Team Up!** Group students into teams. Assign each team a heroic character trait. Encourage each team to discuss and list ways to achieve the heroic character trait displayed on their poster. Allow time for each team to share their suggestions. Display the list of suggestions on or near the Super Power Heroic Students Bulletin Board.

**Role-Playing Reinforcement** After discussing each heroic character trait, have student volunteers demonstrate heroic character traits from Super Power Heroic Students Mini Bulletin Board. Students should demonstrate a heroic action through role play and have the class identify the actions being portrayed. After the action has been identified, students should repeat the activity. Allow each student to have a turn role-playing until all 10 heroic character traits have been identified.

**Unstoppable!** Motivate students to be a heroic student by posting the heroic posters on a wall. Program the shield accents with students' names. When a student displays a heroic character trait, his shield can be placed below the corresponding trait.

**Super Rewards** Use the reproducible reward coupons [page 4] to reward students when they exhibit heroic character traits that are listed on the Super Power Heroic Students Mini Bulletin Board.

## Using the Super Power Heroic Students Mini Bulletin Board

### Language Arts

**Vocabulary** Program blank index cards with several of the vocabulary words from the Super Power Heroic Students Mini Bulletin Board such as respect, encourage, honest, and brave. Place the cards, along with a dictionary, in a language arts center. Have students choose a vocabulary word and write the definition of what they think the word means on the front. Then, have them check their definitions with the definition listed in a dictionary. Students should write the correct definitions, if needed, on the backs of the cards.

**Friendly Letters** Ask students to think about someone who has recently shown a heroic character trait. Review the parts of a friendly letter. Then, have each student write a letter thanking a person for demonstrating a heroic character trait and telling him how this good example affected her. Remind students to use character trait words from the Super Power Heroic Students Mini Bulletin Board. Display copies of the letters around the bulletin board.

**Inspiring Hero Biographies** Program slips of paper with the 10 heroic character traits listed on the Super Power Heroic Students Mini Bulletin Board posters. Allow each student to draw a slip of paper and read the assigned character trait. Provide students with books, magazines, or the Internet to research famous people who used that character trait to become successful, overcome obstacles, or design a new invention. Students should write short biographies about the persons they research. Display the biographies around the bulletin board.

**Heroic Poetry** Have students write an acrostic poem. Write the word hero down the left side of the paper. Students should write a word or sentence that would describe characteristics of a hero for each letter such as:

Helps those in need

Everywhere, everyday

Relies on their own strength

Oh, to be a HERO!

Display the completed poems around the Super Power Heroic Students Mini Bulletin Board.
