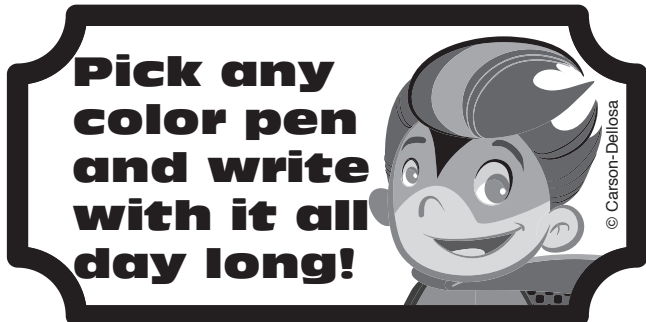

Using the Super Power Super Work Habits Mini Bulletin Board

Classroom Management Place the Super Power Super Work Habits Mini Bulletin Board posters around the room or on a bulletin board to remind and encourage students to display super work habits throughout the day.

Group Influence Place students in seven small groups. Assign each group a super work habit. Encourage each group to discuss and list ways to achieve the super work habits displayed on their posters. Allow time for each group to share their suggestions. Display the list of suggestions on or near the Super Power Super Work Habits Mini Bulletin Board.

Role-Playing Reinforcement After discussing each super work habit, allow students to role-play to show their knowledge of the good work habits. Call a pair of students to the front of the class to demonstrate a super work habit from the Super Power Super Work Habits Mini Bulletin Board. Have the pair demonstrate a work habit through role play and ask the class to identify the work habit being portrayed. After the work habit has been identified, students should repeat the activity. Allow each student to take a turn role-playing until all seven good work habits are identified.

Powerful Motivation Motivate students toward super work habits by posting the super work habits posters on a wall. Below each poster, display pieces of poster board labeled with students' names. At the end of each day or week, place a sticker next to each student's name to indicate which super work habit(s) she exhibited. Each student should receive at least one sticker to show that everyone has super work habits.

Super Rewards Use the reproducible reward coupons [page 4] to reward students when they exhibit the super work habits that are listed on the Super Power Super Work Habits Mini Bulletin Board.

Using the Super Power Super Work Habits Mini Bulletin Board

Vocabulary Program blank index cards with several of the vocabulary words from the Super Power Super Work Habits Mini Bulletin Board such as *independent*, *manage*, *habit*, and *organize*. Place the cards, along with a dictionary, in a language arts center. Have students choose vocabulary words and write what they think the word means on the front. Then, have them check their definitions with the definition listed in a dictionary. Students should write the correct definitions, if needed, on the backs of the cards.

Friendly Letters Ask students to think about someone who has recently shown a super work habit. Review the parts of a friendly letter. Then, have each student write a letter thanking a person for demonstrating a super work habit and telling him how this good example affected her. Remind students to use character trait words from the Super Power Super Work Habits Mini Bulletin Board. Display copies of the letters around the bulletin board.

Super Shape Poetry Have students draw a simple outline of a superhero with a cape. Around the outside of the outlines, students should write words from the Super Power Super Work Habits Mini Bulletin Board or other words that describe super work habits to create a superhero shape poem. Have students add details and color to the poem. Display the poems around the Super Power Super Work Habits Mini Bulletin Board.
