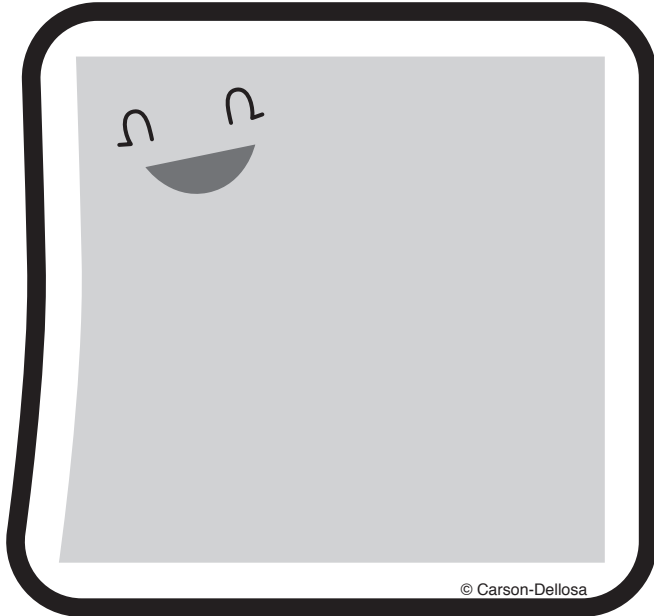
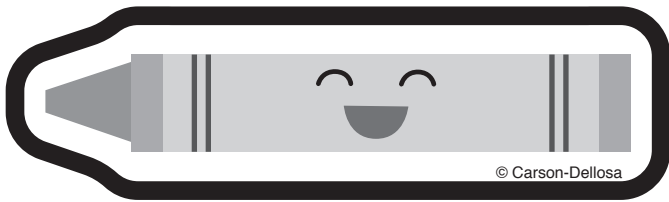

### Putting It Together

## Activities

### Classroom Management

**Notable Teams** Use the School Pop School Tools Mini Bulletin Board to form cooperative teams. Distribute a notepad accent to each student. Students will form their teams by matching the colors of their notepads.

**Happy Centers** Use the larger accent pieces such as the crayon box, notebook paper, and composition notebook to label centers. Program the notepad accents or copies of the notepad pattern [page 4] with students' names. Place the names in the corresponding centers.

**Job Well Done** When a student is caught "being good" or displaying good work habits, place a speech bubble accent or a copy of a speech bubble pattern [page 3] on his desk to reward him for a job well done.

### Math

**Bright Patterns** Use the School Pop School Tools Mini Bulletin Board in a math center for pattern practice. Encourage students to place the school tool accents or copies of the school tool patterns [page 4] into various growing and repeating patterns. Students should record the patterns they form in a math journal and label them growing pattern or repeating pattern.

### Language Arts

**Sweet Short Stories** Use the School Pop School Tools Mini Bulletin Board to spark creative writing. Have students choose one of the school tool accents. Each student should write a short story about the day in the life of the school tool. The story should be written from the school tool's point of view. Display the stories around the School Pop School Tools Mini Bulletin Board.

### Character Education

**Bright Compliments** Give each student a notepad accent or a copy of the notepad pattern [page 4]. Have each student write a compliment about one of her classmates on the notepad. Display the compliments around the School Pop School Tools Mini Bulletin Board.
