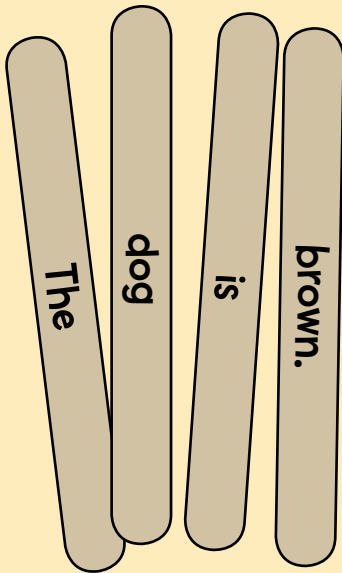
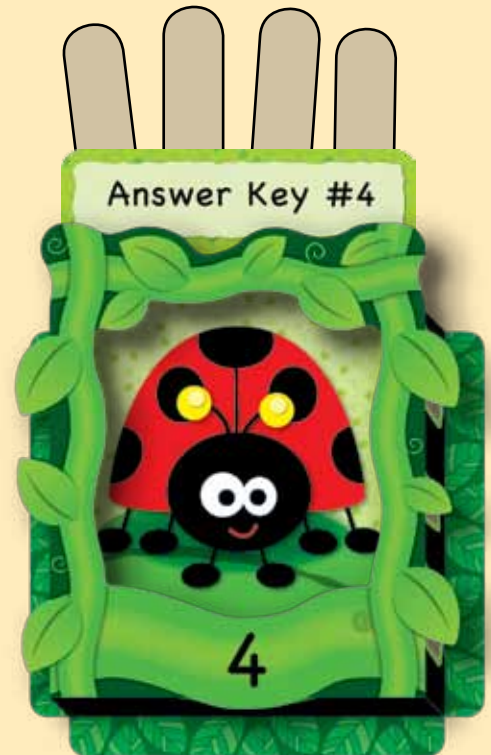


LadyBug Sentence Scramble



The dog is brown.



Items Used for this Project:

- CD-108074 Pop-Its™ Pockets Ladybugs
- Wooden craft sticks
- Poster board (optional)

Directions:

Students build sentences using a given set of words. Display the pockets on a small bulletin board or attach them to a sheet of poster board. Label the pockets with the numbers 1 through 12. Title each card *Answer Key* ____ (insert numbers 1 through 12). Write a short sentence on the back of each card, such as *The dog is brown*. Write each word of the sentence on a separate wooden craft stick. To help students return their sticks to the correct pocket, write the pocket number on the back of each wooden craft stick. Place the word sticks in the correct sentence pocket. Have students choose a pocket, remove the sticks, and place them in order to make a correct sentence. Students can also write the sentences on a sheet of paper. Students can check their work using the answer key on the corresponding card.

Helpful Tip:

For added support, use different colorful markers to highlight the uppercase letter in the first word of the sentence. Punctuation marks can also be highlighted. Index cards can be substituted for the wooden craft sticks.
