## A sentence must have correct end punctuation.

- Use a question mark ( ? ), a period ( . ), or an exclamation point ( ! ) at the end of a sentence.

Examples:

(Question) How large were the first flying vertebrates?

(Statement) Pterosaurs were bigger than F-16 fighter jets.

(Strong emotion) That is amazing!

(Command) Now, look at this drawing of the smallest Pterosaur.

A sentence is not complete without end punctuation. For example, if you take away my cute ears, I just wouldn't be complete! What did you say? Hey, give me back my ears!
